

Required Application Documents:

(These must be attached to your application. All materials must be received by 5 pm EDT on May 15, 2008.)

- An official transcript or letter from a school official from the institution most recently attended.
- A 250 word essay outlining how being a junior firefighter has impacted your life and how the scholarship will further your field of study.
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter should be from a teacher, employer, or a member of the community familiar with you and your goals. The other recommendation should be from your fire department's chief or the coordinator of your junior firefighter program.
- Recent photograph to be used for NVFC and Dunkin' Brands Community Foundation newsletters, web sites, etc., if you are selected.
- The fire department in conjunction with which you serve(d) as a junior firefighter must submit a 250 word essay outlining its current junior firefighter program and how a \$5,000 grant would benefit the department's junior firefighter program. The program must be registered with the National Junior Firefighter Program. If your program is not currently registered, the department can do so for free at www.nvfc.org/juniors.
