

# William J. Darley Lifetime Achievement Award

Sponsored by Darley

The National Volunteer Fire Council's (NVFC) William J. Darley Lifetime Achievement Award, sponsored by Darley, annually honors those individuals whose remarkable achievements in the fire service and community exemplifies outstanding performance. To be considered for the award, nominees must have been a volunteer firefighter for at least 20 years. Nominations can be made posthumously.

The nomination period is open from December 18, 2024 – January 17, 2025.

### Criteria

Each nominee will be judged on the following criteria:

- Nominee has made a major contribution or has achieved significant accomplishments in the volunteer fire service on a local, state, and/or national level.
- Nominee has demonstrated superior dedication to the volunteer fire service and has served as a volunteer firefighter for at least twenty (20) years.
- Nominee has been active in their state firefighters' association.
- Nominee has demonstrated community impact through the fire service or other volunteer activities.

#### **Nomination Materials**

Nominations must be received by 5pm EST on January 17, 2025. Nomination packets must include:

- Completed nomination form
- 500-word essay describing the nominee's accomplishments in and dedication to the volunteer fire service
- Detailed resume or background sheet of no more than two (2) pages containing an overview of the individual's experience, education, or other pertinent information
- Two (2) letters of recommendation supporting the nominee
- Up to three (3) additional supporting documents, such as articles or additional recommendation letters (optional). Only the first three additional supporting documents submitted will be reviewed.

<sup>\*</sup> NVFC board members are not eligible for three years after they end their service on the board. Former award recipients are not eligible until 10 years after their previous award. Nominee must have obtained the majority of their fire service experience in the United States and must be a U.S. citizen.

<sup>\*</sup> Please note: If chosen, award recipient must submit a digital photo to be used for NVFC newsletters, web sites, etc.
