

Why Should Firefighters Use a Wet Wipe to Clean Their Skin After a Fire Response?



The neck, face, and hands are highly susceptible to soot exposure, making these the easiest places for fireground substances to meet the skin. **Using a wet wipe on-scene** after response helps clean these areas of harmful substances before they get absorbed into the body.
